Registration Form Pages 2 & 3- Parade Rules and Waiver: Please initial each statement below to show you have read and acknowledged the following parade rules.

9: Motorized or horse entrants must forward proof of liability insurance of a minimum of \$100,000.

10: All entries must have entertainment value (i.e. giving out candy, playing music, dancing, etc.). Units will NOT be allowed with a sole purpose of advertising. We ask for no political entries in the parade at this time.

11: No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on any unit. If any driver of a unit permits this, they will be ticketed under the Open Container Law. There will be no warnings.

12: Water guns/squirt guns will not be allowed on any unit.

13: No throw outs of any kind will be allowed from any vehicle or float. All items must be handed out from sidelines. This is very important for the safety of the children and other parade units.

14: All units must check in and be in position one hour before the parade starts. The parade starts promptly at 12:00pm.

15: All entries must maintain a steady pace. No stopping to do performances.

16: No float or unit shall be more than 14 feet in width or 65 feet in length.

17: The Glad Days Committee shall at times have complete supervision, direction, and control over the services of the performers and expressly reserves the right to control the manner, means, and details of the performance of services by the performer.

18: All entries are subject to approval by the Glad Days Committee.
